Prescription Goggles	The FINIS Smart Goggles are not available in prescription lenses. But if you wear reading glasses you can still see the screen!	Unfortunately, the FORM Smart Swim Goggles are not available in a prescription version. However, many swimmers who wear prescription glasses are able to see the metrics on our smart display clearly. I use reading glasses and had no problem seeing the screen.
Smart unit removable	Yes – it can be removed and put into another compatible goggle.	No
Position of display	Left hand side so the swimmer can ignore if needed. You can adjust the brightness in the App.	In view all of the time but this is not an issue. You can adjust the display for brightness.
